**November is the month of the Holy Souls. During this month we are called to help the Holy Souls in Purgatory by:**

- Have Masses offered for them
- Pray the Rosary and the Chaplet for the Holy Souls
- Pray the Stations of the Cross
- Offer up little sacrifices and fast
- Spread devotion to them
- Attend Eucharistic Adoration and pray for them
- Gain all the indulgences you can, and apply them to the Holy Souls
- Visit a Cemetery

An indulgence, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, is granted to the faithful, who devoutly visit a cemetery and pray, even if only mentally, for the departed. The indulgence is plenary each day from the 1<sup>st</sup> to the 8<sup>th</sup> of November; on other days of the year it is partial.

Here at Regina Coeli we must not forget that we have a Cemetery on our grounds, the site of the original Regina Coeli Church. Perhaps we could remember to make a visit there and pray for the souls whose mortal remains are interred there. Below is a list of those interred.

“In the ‘village’ area of Hyde Park, as a person walks down Harvey Street, just before he makes the turn on Park Place, he might notice a concrete slab on the left surrounded by an odd-shaped sidewalk. On the concrete slab is a stone marker with eight names (all from the same family) carved into the stone surface: Mortimer Livingston(1807-1857); Silvie Depau Livingston(1808-1882); William Sydney Drayton(1813-1860); Sylvia Livingston Drayton Kirkpatrick(1830-1882); Mortimer L. Drayton(1853-1855); Catharine L. Drayton(1859-1860); Maud Drayton(1857-1885); and Percival Langdon Drayton(1858-1892). By this time, the observer probably realizes he is looking at a burial vault. The sidewalk, which surrounds the vault, actually delineates the outline of one of the first Catholic Churches in Dutchess County, the “old” Regina Coeli Church. It was a small, but wonderful church with elaborate statues, paintings, and woodwork on the inside and Neo-Gothic architecture on the outside. It was the gift of one person, Sylvia Livingston Drayton in 1862. She is one of the eight people buried in the vault, which was once under the altar of the old church. Her story is interesting (as is the story of the other family members in the vault.)” (taken from the History of Hyde Park-On-Hudson by Carney Rhinevault.)
