HIS WORD TODAY

“Jesus began speaking in the synagogue:

‘Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing.’

All who were present spoke favorably of him; they marveled at the appealing discourse which came from his lips. They also asked, ‘Is this not Joseph’s son?’ ...At these words the whole audience in the synagogue was filled with indignation. They rose up and expelled him from the town...”

It didn't take many verses in the gospel of St. Luke to find a conversion, not to but away from Jesus. The person, admired and respected, became the challenger. He knew their hearts and was found to be too much for them. He told it like it was.

We are called to turn constantly to the Lord. We hear His word proclaimed and a teaching on a weekly basis. God's word is 'like a two edged sword' which can cut deeply, inform and reform our lives. Sometimes we do not care for what we hear, because it challenges our way of life, our pattern of thinking, or our relationship with others. But remember, what is important is our relationship with God.

As I recreate the scene in the Nazareth synagogue, I ask myself if I marvel at what I hear and how I respond.
