Lent is a time of penance and self-denial. In that spirit we are trying something new this year. As you can see, the statues are covered and the church is barely adorned. Depriving ourselves of artistic beauty helps us to humble ourselves and focus on the coming passion and death of Our Lord. A striking contrast will occur at the Easter Vigil Mass when the church is decorated in spectacular fashion to mark the end of Lent and celebrate the glorious resurrection of Our Lord. A special thanks to the parishioners who graciously provided the coverage.

LENTEN OBLIGATIONS

The Season of Lent also presents the faithful with some obligations that we must be reminded about. **FASTING** prescribes that only one full meal a day and two smaller meals may be taken to maintain strength but these two taken together should not equal another full meal. Fasting obliges from the 18TH TO 59TH year. Abstinence forbids the eating of meat. Abstinence Obliges from 14TH Birthday on. Ash Wednesday & Good Friday are days of Fast & Abstinence from meat!!! All Fridays of Lent are day of Abstinence from meat.

The Events of Lent & Holy Week

Lent is an Anglo-Saxon word meaning *spring*. The season lasts from Ash Wednesday until the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday.

Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent, observed by receiving a cross of ashes on the forehead at mass.
