Its endorsed priests and deacons are responsible for pastoral services to approximately 1.8 million Catholics.

Unlike a conventional (arch)diocese, the *Archdiocese for the military Services, USA*, has no parishes or parish registries. It has no weekly collections, relying solely on the generosity of private donations to support its programs and services.

Last year, Pope Francis told military ordinaries from around the world that "The role of military chaplains is to accompany and support [those in need] on the journey, to be a comforting and brotherly presence for them all."
