FOURTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME – JULY 3, 2016

A Hudson Valley Journey

A few weeks ago, A professor from a university in Canada visited the Archives of the Archdiocese of New York, for the purpose of researching the subject of relations of the Catholic Church with the British Mandate of Palestine and the State of Israel, post World War One to the 1980's. Invariably, the discussion turned to the subject of his proposed research visits to the Franklin D. Roosevelt Presidential Library in Hyde Park, and the Harry S Truman Presidential Library in Independence, Missouri. No sooner had I finished telling the professor that the FDR Library was just a short run up from the Archives in Yonkers, that I received a phone call from the Archdiocese of New York, informing me that His Eminence, Timothy Cardinal Dolan had appointed me pastor of Regina Coeli Church, Hyde Park. Very providential! A conversation about Hyde Park unwittingly was followed by an appointment to the Catholic parish in Hyde Park!

I am so deeply grateful to Cardinal Dolan, for entrusting me with the spiritual care of the good people at Regina Coeli Parish. I was ordained to the priesthood on May 13, 1989 and spent eighteen years in parish work...nine of those as an administrator and pastor before being appointed to the faculty of Saint Joseph's Seminary, Yonkers, New York in 2007 and in 2011, named by then-Archbishop Timothy Dolan as archivist of the Archdiocese of New York. I believe it is fortuitous that a priest who loves the study of history should be assigned to a parish with such a rich historical patrimony.

Back in March of this year, Father Douglas Crawford, pastor of neighboring Good Shepherd Church in Rhinebeck invited me to preach a two-day Lenten reflection. Being with the parishioners for those two brief days reminded me how much I really missed full-time parish ministry. I even quipped to Father Crawford, "I could see myself in a parish like this." And so it is.

There is a significant amount of transitional work for my successor at the Archives, and since the summertime is the "busy season" for the Archives, when professors have more freedom to venture away from campus for research, I have received permission from His Eminence to begin my work at Regina Coeli on August 1. I will be coming up regularly during July so I am certain our paths will cross. In the meantime, please be assured of my prayers and remembrances at daily Mass. And also know that on Friday, June 24, 2016, I made a special pilgrimage to the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, D.C. with the specific intentions of commending the parishioners of Regina Coeli Parish to the care of Our Lady. Prayers also for our shepherd, Father Brendan Fitzgerald, both in thanksgiving for fostering such a reverent, prayerful, and caring environment at Regina Coeli, and as he begins his apostolate at Saint Barnabas Church, Woodlawn/McLean Heights, Bronx-Yonkers, where both of us had previously served (but at different times) as parochial vicars.

In the meantime, let us pray for one another and rejoice in the Lord's love and mercy. Queen of Heaven, rejoice!
