Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

Jesus, in his great love for us, has given us the Sacrament of Baptism, remitting us of the stain of original sin. Nonetheless, despite our freedom from its grip, we continue to feel the effects of original sin in our lives. Our human tendency to commit sin, contradictions and sufferings, and even little annoyances can be traced to the effects of original sin. But as Saint Paul tells us in his Letter to the Romans, 6:23, the greatest consequence of original sin is death.

Saint John Paul II so beautifully described our Lady as the *Mother of Her Creator*. It only makes sense that since Mary was chosen to bear the Son of God...to be, in effect, the *first tabernacle* of Our Lord, that she be conceived immaculately, namely without the stain of original sin. And since the ultimate consequence of sin is death, the sinless Blessed Virgin Mary would not die, but be assumed body and soul into Heaven. Since the beginnings of the Church, starting with the Early Church Fathers, there has been the implicit belief that Our Lady was assumed body and soul into Heaven. But it was not until November 1, 1950, with the promulgation of the Apostolic Constitution of Pope Pius XII, *Munificentissimus Deus*, that this ageless gem of the Faith was declared a *dogma* of the Church:

With the course of her earthly life brought to completion, the Immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary, was taken body and soul into celestial glory.

Pius XII, *Munificentissimus Deus*. November 1, 1950

Our Eastern Catholic and Eastern Orthodox brothers and sisters refer to Our Lady's Assumption as the Dormition - a "falling asleep." The iconography of the Dormition shows a sleeping Blessed Virgin surrounded by the weeping apostles, joy filled angels, and our Divine Lord, there to greet His Mother. Very beautiful! Very fitting for the Mother of God.

On December 13, 1991, the National Conference of Catholic Bishops (now the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops) decreed:

Whenever January 1, the Solemnity of Mary, the Mother of God, or August 15, the Solemnity of the Assumption, or November 1, the Solemnity of All Saints falls on a Saturday or a Monday, the precept to attend Mass is abrogated.

Since the Solemnity of the Assumption falls on a Monday (tomorrow), this solemnity is not a holy day of obligation this year. However, Regina Coeli will avail the parish family a full holy day schedule of Masses: 7:00 a.m., 9:00 a.m., and 7:30 p.m. What a wonderful tribute to the Mother of God to partake in the greatest gift Our Lord has given us, the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass on her special day! Father Pani and I are hoping to see you at Mass on Our Lady's special day!
