## HAPPY FEAST DAY TO OUR PARISH FAMILY

Tomorrow, Monday, August 22 is the Memorial of the Queenship of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the feast day of our parish, Regina Coeli, Queen of Heaven. Our parish, founded in 1863, predates the establishment of this memorial for the Universal Church. Pius XII instituted this memorial on December 8, 1954 in acknowledgment of the time-held belief and tradition that Our Lady, as the Mother of Christ the King, is Queen of Heaven and Earth.

In his March 25, 1987 encyclical, Redemptoris Mater On the Blessed Virgin Mary in the Life of the Pilgrim Church, Saint John Paul II writes:

The Mother of Christ is glorified as the 'Queen of Universe.' She who called herself the 'handmaid of the Lord' at the Annunciation remained faithful to what this name expresses through her earthly life. In this, she confirmed that she was a true 'disciple' of Christ, who strongly emphasized that his mission was out of service: The Son of Man 'came not to be served but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many (Matthew 20: 28). In this way, Mary became the first of those who, 'serving Christ also in others, with humility and patience, lead their brothers and sisters to that King to serve whom is to reign, and she fully achieves that 'state of royal freedom' proper to Christ's disciples: To serve Christ is to reign with Him...Her 'glory in serving' is completely compatible with her royal exaltation. Taken up into Heaven, she does not cease her service for the sake of our salvation.

The reign of Our Lady as Queen of Heaven and Earth is real and prevalent. For instance, during the Paschal season, the Regina Coeli is prayed at the first, sixth, twelfth, and eighteenth hour of each day. When we pray the Glorious Mysteries of the Holy Rosary on Wednesdays and Sundays, we conclude this powerful prayer tool with the Fifth Glorious Mystery, "The Crowning of Our Blessed Lady, Queen of Heaven and of Earth." So often following the Holy Rosary do we pray the Litany of Loreto, where we extol Our Lady as Queen of Angels, Queen of Patriarchs, Queen of Prophets, Queen of Apostles, Queen of Martyrs, Queen of confessors, Queen of Virgins...Queen of All the Saints.

Mary is not like earthly royalty, often distant, removed from the populace, and surrounded by pomp and formality. Mary is our Mother and she is completely accessible. Just a Hail Mary, a litany, a rosary or a spontaneous prayer of intercession away.

Enjoy our special day!
