Respect Life Sunday October 2, 2016

On the road to Calvary, Jesus told the women of Jerusalem:

Daughters of Jerusalem, do not weep for me but weep for yourselves and for your children. Behold, the days are coming when they will say, 'Blessed are the barren, and the wombs that never bore, and the breasts that never nursed! Then they will begin to say to the mountains, 'Fall on us'; and the hills, 'Cover us.' For if they do this when the wood is green, what will happen when it is dry?' - Luke 23: 28-31, Revised Standard Version.

If they do this when the wood is green..." In His final hours, might Jesus have been referring to the taking of innocent unborn human life?

With the coming of October, the Church and the nation begin Respect Life Month. In this month of Our Lady and the Holy Rosary, we pray, fast, and work for an end to the scourge of abortion in our nation. Since the landmark United States Supreme Court decision, *Roe v. Wade*, of January 22, 1973, fifty-four million abortions have taken place in the United States. How could the greatest nation in the history of civilization allow this to happen?

We as a nation are better than this. Recently, many hearts and minds have been converted to the cause of life. In fact, some of the most fervent leaders of the pro-life movement had been victims of abortion or were powerful supporters of pro-abortion public policies. That is the power of prayer...that is the power of mercy...that is the power of the Sacrament of Penance.

On Wednesday, September 21, Maureen Haege, a parishioner at our neighboring parish, Good Shepherd Church in Rhinebeck gave a powerful talk to the Dutchess County Clergy Deanery, gathered here at Regina Coeli Church on the subject of **40 Days for Life**, September 28 through November 6 – two days prior to Election Day (see flyer insert in today's bulletin). Ms. Haege recounted some incredible stories of conversion and unborn lives saved – more than one would ever imagine! Her talk was very encouraging for the priests and deacons gathered at our parish. In the words of the great German theologian, Msgr. Romano Guardini, "Love does such things."

Respect Life Sunday and Respect Life Month is also a pointed reminder of God's great mercy. No one, who is truly sorry for sin is ever outside of the realm of His forgiveness. For some people, Respect Life activities might lead to guilt or renewed sadness over past decisions. That is understandable. But all of us are sinners and we always have the great Sacrament of Penance available to us anytime we encounter a priest. The Sacrament of Penance has many names – "Confession," and more recently, "Reconciliation." Perhaps it can be known too as the "Sacrament of Liberation."

As we begin the month of October, we commend to prayer all who labor in the defense of human life. May we trust in God's mercy, the motherly care of Our Lady, and the power of the Holy Rosary.
