Installation of Father Michael P. Morris as the Twenty-Sixth Pastor of the Church of Regina Coeli – Saint Paul, Sunday, October 23, 2016

The leaves are turning color, the Lower Hudson Valley is ablaze in Autumnal splendor, and throughout the Archdiocese of New York, a number of our priests are being installed as new pastors. I was invited to participate in the Mass of Installation, for Father Douglas Crawford, our neighbor at Good Shepherd Parish in Rhinebeck at the Saturday, October 15 Vigil Mass. My apologies for missing all of our five 'o'clock Vigil Mass family members this weekend at Regina Coeli. I will give your regards to our neighbors to the immediate north!

Next week, at the 11:30am, Sunday, October 23 Mass, in fulfillment of the requirements set forth in the 1983 Code of Canon Law, Canon 527, I will be installed as the twenty-sixth pastor of our historic parish. I am most grateful to His Eminence, Timothy Cardinal Dolan for entrusting me with the pastoral care of this wonderful community. And our parish family so very much looks forward to welcoming the Rev. Msgr. James Sullivan, Dean of Ulster County, who will administer the Oath of Fidelity and the other requisite prayers and instructions for the installation of a new pastor. Interestingly, it was then-Father Sullivan who vested me with the stole and chasuble at my priestly ordination at Saint Patrick's Cathedral on May 13, 1989. God wills it!

Many thanks to the members of our parish family who have been planning the reception that will take place in the school hall after the Mass. Sometimes, parishioners and family members might give gifts to the newly installed pastor. Please, I implore all our good parishioners, no gifts! The real gift is to be here! But if there may be an inclination to give a gift, please give such an offering to either Regina Coeli Parish, or the Eastern Lieutenancy of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem, a papal order founded during the First Crusade by Godfrey de Bouillon in A.D. 1099. The Equestrian Order, of which I am a Knight Commander, is charged by Pope Francis and his predecessors, as well as the Order's grand master, Edwin Cardinal O'Brien, with the spiritual and material care of Christians in the Holy Land.
