Say “Yes” to Life

Hard to believe that the month of October – Respect Life Month and the Month of the Holy Rosary is almost over. As Election Day fast approaches, we recall the words of the words of the Most Rev. Samuel Aquila, Archbishop of Denver:

The right to life is the most important and fundamental right, since life is necessary for any of the other rights to matter.

That pretty much says it all. There cannot be civil rights if there is no human person and since the United States Supreme Court’s judicial fiat, Roe v. Wade, January 22, 1973, fifty four million unborn persons never had the opportunity to enjoy the vast array of civil rights offered to members of American society. And with the June 27, 2016 Supreme Court ruling Whole Women’s Health v. Hellerstadt, which sadly re-affirmed the “constitutional” right to abortion on demand in the United States, the uphill climb in favor of life is becoming steeper and steeper.

Abortion has become a national trauma. Occasionally, we will see a bumper sticker that provides a very horrifying and pointed message: “Abortion: One Dead, many wounded.” It is a reminder that the unborn baby is the primary victim and that the parents and relatives suffer greatly from the consequences of a decision made usually in despair. But as Saint Augustine once said, “The greatness and power of God’s creative goodness is overshadowed by the breadth of His mercy.” God is so merciful to those who seek forgiveness, no matter how great the sin. Christ commands that we be forgiven.

The entrenchment of the abortion culture in American society can lead us to discouragement and even hopelessness. That is exactly what the devil wants. He loves despair. But we have hope, especially through prayer, recourse to the sacraments, and a greater love for the Holy Rosary.
