Regina Coeli's "Cemetery"

On a little fenced-in plot on the west side of our parish grounds, off Harvey Street, lies the footprint of the original church building of Regina Coeli Parish, built in 1864 and used continuously as the parish church until the dedication of the "new" church by Francis Cardinal Spellman on May 8, 1966. Within the wrought iron fencing lies a crypt where the remains of eight linear descendants of Robert Livingston, chancellor of the State of New York, who administered the oath of office to President George Washington on April 30, 1789, Philip Livingston, a signer of the Declaration of Independence, and the French naval officer, Joseph Comte de Grasse, hero of the Battle of Yorktown that ended the American Revolution in 1781. A recent convert to Catholicism, Sylvia Livingston Drayton Fitzpatrick used her own personal funds to construct the original church building. We certainly owe a debt of gratitude to this holy and determined woman.

During this month of November, the month of the Holy Souls, how efficacious it will be for us to stop by the crypt and offer a prayer of gratitude and to pray for the repose of their souls. Throughout this month, the crypt will be graced with a lovely wreath and a little red votive light to serve as a reminder to all that this little crypt is certainly a holy place.
