## Happy Thanksgiving

The celebration of holy Mass, the Eucharistic sacrifice is founded in *praise and thanksgiving*. For this reason, the civic celebration of Thanksgiving is essentially Catholic in nature. We gather for celebrations with family and friends, praising God for the blessings that have been given to us. Although it is not a holy day of obligation, many of us prefer to begin the celebration of Thanksgiving with morning Mass. So as we prepare for the civic holiday of Thanksgiving, we thank God for His goodness, and may we commend to prayer, those who may approach this season with the burdens of economic hardship, family strife, and loneliness.

This Sunday is also the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. This Solemnity of Christ the King ushers in the Thirty-Fourth Week of Ordinary Time – the last week of the liturgical year. Hard to believe, but next week will be the First Sunday of Advent.

Saint John Paul II in an address on November 20, 1983, described the Solemnity of Christ the King as “the synthesis of the entire salvific mystery,” namely, that with the closing of the liturgical year, the solemnity is the culmination of a year’s worth of celebrations of the mysteries of our Lord’s saving work. We have experienced Christmas, Epiphany, Our Lord’s Passion, Resurrection, and Ascension. On this day modernity, often indifferent to the majesty and love of Jesus, is reminded that Jesus has dominion over the universe.

The ultimate message of the Solemnity of Christ the King is that Jesus is in complete control. His dominion should bestow upon us peace, so long as we trust his providence.
