Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children

January 23, 2017

Msgr. William B. Smith, S.T.D. (1939-2009) was a revered priest of the Archdiocese of New York and a world-renowned moral theologian who specialized in medical ethics and life issues. Msgr. Smith taught moral theology at Saint Joseph's Seminary, Dunwoodie from 1971 until his death in January 2009. So respected was Msgr. Smith that prospective seminarians from various regions of the United States would actually leave their home dioceses to study for the Archdiocese of New York so that they could be instructed by this master moral theologian. Msgr. Smith, a native of Yonkers (and fiercely proud of the "City of Gracious Living") was so imbued with the truth, that when he administered his weekly true-false quizzes, we seminarians always aced them because all we had to do was look at his face. If the answer was "false," his chiseled visage would grow contorted, so much so was he distressed by anything that was not the truth.

Msgr. Smith had an old adage: "Social engineering is always preceded by verbal engineering." Soften the words, and anything can be accomplished, especially in the realm of evil. For instance, support for abortion is referred to as "the right to choose." Sounds positive, right? Everyone likes to have a choice. "Fetus" sounds a lot more clinical than "unborn child."

Changing verbiage and terminology, rightly according to Msgr. Smith is likened to the camel sticking his nose into the tent. Back in the mid-1980's Msgr. Smith would tell us that the abortion movement presented a slippery slope toward human annihilation. He prophetically contented that abortion was the gateway to assisted suicide and other related assaults on the dignity of the family and the rights of the human person. All these prophesies tragically have come true in our times.

Today, January 22, 2017 marks the forty-fourth anniversary of a great American tragedy, the decision of the United States Supreme Court, Roe v. Wade. Tomorrow, January 23, the Church in the United States will observe the "Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children." Our nation, truly the greatest in the history of civilization is too good to allow this attack on defenseless human life. So on this day, and every day, we pray for an end to the crime of abortion in our land and throughout the world. And may we commend to prayer all mothers and fathers who suffer from this horrible sin. May they flee to the loving embrace of God's mercy through trustful contrition. Nothing is beyond the pale of God's mercy!
