A Married Priesthood?

On Thursday, March 9, the German newspaper, **Die Ziet**, Released the contents of an interview with Pope Francis. Included in the discussion were statements made by the pope regarding a proposed Vatican study on the possibility of ordaining married men to the priesthood. Word of this proposal sent negative shockwaves on one end of the spectrum and hope for change on the other end of the pole. However, the pontiff's proposal to open such a study and his thoughts on a married priesthood is a little more complicated and nuanced than what might appear at face value. Firstly, Pope Francis does not wish to abolish the time-tested discipline of clerical celibacy, a hallmark of the priesthood and the episcopacy in the Latin Rite Church (as opposed to the Eastern Rite Church which includes Ruthenians, Rusyns, Ukrainians, Melkites, Maronites and such). It is simply the suggestion by the pope of a study to investigate the practice of clerical celibacy.

The pope proffered a consideration of virii probati, namely "tested men" who would serve as priests in remote areas where the shortage of priests is most grave. Here's where it gets a bit complicated. Would these "tested men" be privileged with the same priestly faculties as their celibate brothers? Would they be granted faculties to hear confessions, preach, administer, Anointing of the Sick? After all, prior to the Second Vatican Ecumenical Council (1962-1965, there was a category of clergy known as simplex priests who, for reasons determined by the local bishop or religious provincial or superior, would be granted faculties only to offer Mass but not preach or hear confessions. The most noted simplex priest was the venerable Solanus Casey (1870-1957) who ministered at Sacred Heart Monastery in Yonkers, New York during World War One. Ultimately, it is the authority of the bishop or religious superior or provincial to grant such faculties even to this day. Interestingly, the pope specifically stated that if the ordination of vir probati is eventually permitted in the Latin Rite church these married priests, in keeping with the long standing discipline of clerical celibacy, would be required to refrain from marital relations with their wives. It is important to note that Francis did not lay claim to supporting an end to mandatory clerical celibacy, stating "Voluntary celibacy is often discussed in this context, especially in places where there is a shortage of clerics. But voluntary celibacy is not a solution."

As unmarried priesthood is certainly beneficial to the people of God. In the interest of brevity, next week we will discuss the history, spirituality, and practicality of this time-honored treasure of the Latin Rite Church.
