Holy Week 2017

“Holy Week is ordered to the commemoration of Christ’s passion, beginning with his Messianic entrance into Jerusalem.”

- Order of Prayer in the Liturgy of the Hours and the Celebration of the Eucharist, 2017.

Today, Our Divine Lord processes triumphantly into Jerusalem. In the next few days, Catholics will live Holy Thursday, commemorating the day Jesus instituted the Holy Eucharist, the death of the Messiah on Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil of Christ’s glorious Resurrection. All these events are truly historical. The second century Jewish historian, Josephus wrote of the death of a just man in Jerusalem at the hands of the Roman occupiers. Doubtless, he was referring to Jesus. But Holy Week, the Triduum, and the glories of Easter are more than just historic events. They are the vehicles of our salvation. May the Crucified Lord provide us with hearts truly open to the mysteries of this most sacred time of the liturgical year. And always remember, that Christ died for each and every one of us on that hill at Calvary. If we were the only persons alive at that time, Christ still would have mounted the cross for us.
