## *i*Mercy: The Divine Hotspot

Parish Mission for the People of Regina Coeli and Saint Paul's

Our long anticipated parish mission will begin next week!

Although the mission actually starts on Sunday evening, May 7, 2017, our preacher of the mission, Father William Garrott, O.P. will preach at all the weekend Masses, Saturday evening through Sunday morning, May 6-7. Please note that each mission session begins at 7:00 p.m. Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday. Please feel free to join us for the recitation of the Holy Rosary at 6:40 every evening of the mission. And Fr. Garrott and I will be available for the Sacrament of Penance each evening after the mission.

The mission format includes:

Sunday Evening Message: *i*Mercy: The Father Blesses

Father Garrott's Sunday evening mission message will focus upon the unconditional love of the Father, and concludes with an invitation to individual families (intact, broken, troubled, struggling, separated by great distances etc.) to come forward for a special blessing with holy oil under the patronage of Saint Joseph, foster father of Jesus and Patron of the Universal Church.

Monday Evening Message: *i*Mercy: The Son Heals

The Monday evening preaching will focus upon Jesus' ministry of mercy and concludes with an invitation for those in need of healing (physical, spiritual, and emotional) to come forward to adore the Lord Jesus Christ in the Most Blessed Sacrament within the monstrance held by Father Garrott. Monday evening marks the fifty-first anniversary of the dedication of the new Regina Coeli by the late Francis Cardinal Spellman, Archbishop of New York. The presentation candles that ring the church will be illuminated for this blessed event.

Tuesday Evening Message: *i*Mercy: The Spirit Strengthens

Tuesday evening's message will focus upon the Holy Spirit empowering us to become instruments of God's mercy, having received that mercy ourselves. The mission will conclude with a prayer of renewal followed by an invitation to come forward for a brief silent laying on of hands by Father Garrott, so as to renew and empower us with the Holy Spirit's gifts.

Please pray for the success of the mission and for Father Garrott. Tell your friends and neighbors. All are welcome! This mission will be a great gift for our parish.

## **Urgent Message from Father Morris: Church Vandalized**

**On or about midnight, April 24, 2017, Regina Coeli Church fell victim to a serious act of exterior vandalism on the south side entrance of the church, in the vicinity of the Adoration Chapel. Sadly, the damage included:**

- Six broken stained glass window panels in the east narthex and the Adoration chapel
- A toppled granite bench at the memorial to unborn children.
- A broken monstrance on the statue of Saint Peter Julian Eymard outside of the Adoration Chapel

Particularly odious was the fact that the granite representation of the monstrance was found on the top step of the east entrance...repurposed as an ash tray.

The Hyde Park Police Department has identified the culprit as a young adult from the neighborhood who suffers from profound mental illness. Regardless, this is a heinous act which should be a cause for great alarm and concern for all parishioners. Why was the church building specifically targeted? What is particularly disturbing is the fact that this act of vandalism occurred in the vicinity of the Adoration Chapel. This could have easily happened at a time when a parishioner(s) was in prayer in the chapel. If that were the case, I shudder at the thought of the tragic and frightening consequences. Such concerns must be taken into consideration and addressed.

I continue to be in consultation with the Hyde Park Police Department, our dean of Dutchess County, Msgr. Sullivan, Catholic Mutual (Insurance services of the Archdiocese), and the Office of Legal Affairs of the Archdiocese. The Adoration Chapel remains closed for the time being as we continue a security assessment. Certainly, in the wake of this sad event, there will most certainly be a review of the hours in which the Adoration Chapel will be available for prayer. Of course, all decisions will be made in consultation with our parish staff, Father Pani, our deacons, and our trustees.

Most importantly, please pray for the young man who perpetrated this sacrilegious act. He comes right from our community...our neighborhood. We pray that he may receive the proper medical care that will restore him and give him the peace of Jesus.
