Mothers Day 2017

Blessings to all our mothers on this very special Sunday in May. Although Mother's Day is a secular holiday (some conspiracy theorists believe it was invented by the greeting card companies), it does certainly have a Catholic flavor. On this day, one day after the centenary of the first apparition of Our Lady to the three children at Fatima in Portugal, we are reminded that Catholic motherhood is uniquely modeled upon the life and mission of Mary, the Mother of God.

Mothers Day can be a time of sadness and difficulty for women, who because of certain circumstances, may never have been given the gift of motherhood. On this day, we recognize also that motherhood can also be "spiritual" in nature. I think back upon my two aunts, Alice and Eleanor Morris, who never married but were true spiritual mothers to my two sisters, my twin brother and me. Aunt Alice and Aunt Eleanor were early "career" women, working for many years in New York City, only to come home to take care of their ailing mother (who in her serious illness, told this ten-year old quite emphatically that he would some day be a priest). After my grandmother went back to God, my two aunts traveled the world over...even meeting Norman Mailer on a street in Florence, and spending the afternoon chatting with him (and the following day, they met the great singer, Teresa Brewer and visited with her, just as they had with Mailer the day before). They were women of incredible faith who were second and third mothers to the Morris kids. They loved the Church and were most supportive of my vocation to the priesthood. The quintessential Bronx-born Irish maiden aunts, Alice and Eleanor were true Catholic mothers.

And so on this day, we remember at the Altar all our mothers, living and deceased. And may we commend to prayer all our spiritual mothers who have helped us deepen our relationship with Our Divine Lord and His Holy Mother.

Before we close, let's switch gears. Saint John Bosco (1815-1888) once said. "Jesus wants happy saints, not sad-faced, glum Christians." Similarly, the great twentieth century English writer and Catholic apologist, Hillaire Belloc (1870-1953) wrote:

Wherever the Catholic sun doth shine,
There's always laughter and good red wine.
At least I've always found it so.
Benedicamus Domino!
