Memorial Day 2017

Saint Cyril of Jerusalem, the great fourth century theologian, in his Catechesis writes on the subject of death and the necessity of prayers for the faithful departed:

Then we pray [in the anaphora] for the holy fathers and bishops who have fallen asleep, and in general, for all who have fallen asleep before us, in the belief that it is a great benefit to the souls on whose behalf the supplication is offered, while the holy and tremendous Victim is present...By offering to God our supplications for those who have fallen asleep, if they have sinned, we offer Christ sacrificed for the sins of all, and so render favorable, for them and for us, the God who loves man.

-As found in The Catechism of the Catholic Church, #1371.

St. Cyril outlines the time-tested tradition of the Church, whose members manifest their great love for the faithful departed through the offering of prayers and Masses for the speedy entrance of the souls of our loved ones into Eternal Life. When United States Army Major General John Logan, the post-Civil War national commander of the Union Army veterans association, the Grand Army of the Republic (GAR) issued General Order Number 11, declaring May 30, 1868 Memorial Day or "Decoration Day," the good general probably did not have in mind the traditions of the Church regarding prayer for the dead. But this is what the first Memorial Day was all about: prayer and care for the graves of the more than 650,000 soldiers killed in American Civil War. Throughout the rest of the nineteenth century and well into the last century, Memorial Day had many manifestations (various southern states celebrated Confederate Memorial day in April). It was not until 1971 that Memorial Day became a national holiday, commemorated on the last Monday of May (although some purists continue to celebrate Memorial Day on May 30). Memorial Day, for better or for worse, has since become the unofficial start of the summer season. Regardless, on this very special national holiday, Americans now honor and pray for the souls of all members of the American military who have died in all American wars, both overseas and on American soil.

As Catholics, prayer for the souls of the faithful departed is a part of our spiritual DNA. So it comes naturally for us to pray for the souls of our beloved war dead, whose ultimate sacrifice has contributed to the freedoms we experience as Americans.

Eternal rest grant unto them O Lord. And let perpetual light shine upon them.
