## Pentecost Sunday, 2017

On this Pentecost Sunday, we celebrate that glorious day when the sinless Virgin Mary and the Apostles were given the gifts of the Holy Spirit. Their vocation fulfilled, the Apostles, freed of their incredulity and fears, are empowered to set out into the world to bring the Gospel message...the truth...to all peoples. The noted writer, priest of the Archdiocese of New York, and pastor of the Church of Saint Michael in Midtown Manhattan, Father George Rutler writes:

In preparing for the celebration of Pentecost, the Church prays for a holy reception of the truth “ever ancient ever new” that comes not through a ‘Second Pentecost’ or a ‘Third Pentecost.’ But through an enlivened embrace of God’s timeless grace. Christ makes “all things new” and does not superficially make all new things (Revelation 21:5) Heresies are fads, but the eternal dogmas of the Faith never go out of date because they were never fashionable to begin with.

Cardinal Timothy Dolan, in a reflection on the occasion of the Advent Day of Recollection for priests of the Archdiocese of New York this past December lamented that we now “live in a post-ecclesial world.” Many people who may have received all their sacraments have come to the erroneous conclusion that they can be “spiritual” without the benefit of the Eucharist, the teachings of Christ and the Church (they are one and the same) or communal worship that reaches its summit in the Holy Mass. The “post-ecclesial” world also allows for a spirit of rebellion against the time-honored teachings of Christ which prevent us from becoming prisoners of the age. The post-ecclesial milieu is a “world turned upside down,” where good is evil and evil is good.” It is now virtuous to cater to worldly whims that, in the words of Pope Pius XII are “both fleeting and dangerous.”

G.K. Chesterton (+1936), the great English journalist and noted convert to Catholicism describes adherence to Catholic orthodoxy, no matter how unpopular and scorned, is “romantic.” This writer, now in the early stages of being recognized by the Church as a future saint, describes the Church as a chariot “thundering through the ages...the dull heresies sprawling and prostrate, the wild truth reeling, but erect.”

On this Solemnity of Pentecost, may we be filled with joy, knowing that we are a part of this greatest of gifts, the Catholic Church.
