Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, August 15, 2017

This coming Tuesday, the Church Universal commemorates the great Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, in his Apostolic Constitution, *Munificentissimus Deus*, November 1, 1950, Pope Pius XII included in his declaration of the *Dogma* of the Assumption, the following words:

-Thou art [the Mother of God] who, as it is written, appearest in beauty, and thy virginal body is all holy, all chaste, entirely the dwelling place of God, so that it is henceforth completely exempt from dissolution into dust. Though still human, it's life is changed into the heavenly life of incorruptibility, truly living and gloriously undamaged, and sharing in perfect life...At the end of her earthly life, she is taken up into heavenly glory, body and soul.

Pope Pius continues:

-Our Lady wins the supreme crown of her privileges, to be exempt from the corruption of the tomb. Overcoming death as her Son conquered it previously, she is raised body and soul into heavenly glory.

Although the *Dogma* of the Assumption was proclaimed only sixty-seven years ago, Pius XII simply declared what has been taught since the apostolic era. And the Assumption makes perfect sense. Remembering the words of Saint Paul in his letter to the Romans, 6: 23 "for the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life," Our Lady was conceived without the stain of original sin, and committed no actual sin. So she could not have died, but as our Eastern Catholic and Orthodox brothers and sisters assert, Our Lady simply "fell asleep" (hence the alternative title of this solemnity, *The Dormition*).

Needless to say, the Solemnity of the Assumption is a holy day of obligation. Our Mass times for the Solemnity are:

Monday, August 14 (Vigil Mass): 7:30 p.m.

Tuesday, August 15: 7:00 a.m.; 9:00 a.m.; 7:30 p.m.

Through the intercession of Our Lady of the Assumption, may her Son bestow many blessings upon our families and our parish family.
