## A Religious Test for Public Office?

On Wednesday, September 6, 2017, Amy Barrett, a respected professor of law at the University of Notre Dame, appeared before the United States Senate Judiciary Committee to field questions pertaining to her nomination to a federal judgeship for the Seventh Circuit Court of Appeals in Chicago, Illinois. This devout Catholic attorney and mother of seven encountered opposition that should cause great concern for all peoples of good will. In a law review article from 1998, Ms. Barrett asserted that Catholic judges ought to *recuse themselves* from cases which may clash with Catholic moral principles. Senator Dianne Feinstein (D. California), ranking member of the Senate Judiciary Committee, had this to say about Professor Barrett's quite reasonable offer of recusal in cases that may conflict with Catholic teaching and perhaps natural law itself:

*Why is it that so many of us on this side have the very uncomfortable feeling that – you know, dogma and law are two different things. And I think, whatever a religion is, it has its own dogma. The law is totally different. And I think in your case, professor, when you read your speeches, the conclusion one draws is that the dogma lives loudly within you, and that's of concern when you come to big issues that large numbers of people have fought for years in this country.*

Could it get worse? It sure can. Senator Richard Durbin (D. Illinois) a Catholic queried Professor Barrett:

*Do you consider yourself an orthodox Catholic? Sounds like a religious test to me.*

Since the colonial era, Catholics have weathered quite admirably, stunning manifestations of anti-Catholicism. Our first bishop, John Carroll of Baltimore, cousin of founding father Daniel Carroll of Maryland, in the Early Republic (1789-1815), attempted (often in vain) to foster a Catholic spirit of what he called "peace with our neighbors." But with the growth of European immigration after the 1840's, such dreams for peaceful co-existence were not necessarily reciprocated. True, our first Catholic president, the late John Fitzgerald Kennedy was elected in 1960, but his path to the White House was rocky, and marred with suspicion. And there loomed the specter of New York Governor Alfred E. Smith, the first Catholic presidential candidate, defeated largely by forces of anti-Catholicism in the national elections of 1928.

The late historian and presidential advisor, Arthur Schlesinger, Jr. once referred to hostility to Catholicism as the "last respectable form of bigotry in America." Up until the confirmation hearings of Professor Barrett, it seemed that hostility to Catholicism was veiled and subtle. Maybe not so any more. It is troubling indeed, but in some ways it is a strange compliment. People are often troubled when facing the truth head-on. And as G. K. Chesterton once said, "I never get upset about attacks on the Church; it is like throwing rocks at the sun."
