TWENTY-EIGHTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME – OCTOBER 15, 2017

The Centennial of the Apparitions of Our Lady at Fatima, Portugal

This past Friday, October 13 marked the centennial of the final apparition of Our Blessed Mother at Fatima in central Portugal. On that day, one hundred years ago, 50,000 people accompanied the three visionaries, Servant of God Lucia dos Santos (1907-2005), and Saints Francisco (1908-1919) and Jacinta Marto (1910-1920) on their spiritual journey with Our Lady. Although only the children could see Our Lady in dazzlingly white and gold, the gathering multitude witnessed the terrifying autumnal sun spinning in the sky, trembling, appeared to fall to the earth, and then “dancing” over the heads of the multitudes – not once, but three times! As a result of the “Miracle of the Sun,” a journalist who had repeatedly mocked the events at Fatima in his reports in the Lisbon daily, *O Seculo* was immediately converted back to the Faith of his youth.

In the three secrets of Fatima, Our Lady offered a vision of hell that was interpreted to be the two World Wars (the First World War had been raging for three years at the time of the apparitions). Our Lady also called for the conversion of Russia, which at the time was on the cusp of the November Bolshevik Revolution. The Third Secret, partially revealed on May 12, 2000 (but previously read by Saint John XXIII, Blessed Paul VI, and Saint John Paul II) predicted the martyrdom of a man “clothed in white” who “falls to the ground apparently dead, under a burst of gunfire.” The attempt on the life of Saint John Paul II in Saint Peter’s Square occurred on May 13, 1981 – sixty-four years to the day of the first apparition of Our Lady to the three children. On May 13, 2000, then-Vatican Secretary of State, Angelo Cardinal Sodano issued the following statement to pilgrims gathered in Rome for the beatification of Francisco and Jacinta:

...it appears evident to His Holiness that it was a motherly hand which guided the bullets past, enabling the Pope to halt at the threshold of death.

On May 13, 1982 – one year to the day of the assassination attempt, Saint John Paul made a pilgrimage of faith and gratitude to Fatima. Later, the spent round that almost killed Saint John Paul was placed in the crown of the stature of Our Lady of Fatima at the very spot where Our Lady appeared, the Cova da Iria.

When Our Lady appeared to Saint Bernadette Soubirous in 1858, the message of personal healing would lead to countless pilgrimages of sick and suffering persons to that little French town in the Pyrenees. Our Lady’s message at Fatima is that of healing and peace among nations. In the wake of the recent tragedies in Las Vegas and the continued horrors of war, terrorism, and unnecessary confusion in the Church, Our Lady speaks all the more desperately. Thank goodness that we are armed with the greatest weapon of all, the Holy Rosary.
