The nation and the world were terribly shaken by the horrific killings of those good and holy people who gathered on Sunday morning, this past November 5, at the First Baptist Church, Sutherland Springs, Texas. The morning after the tragedy, our parish brought flowers and a Mass Card to the Hyde Park Baptist Church family, in prayerful solidarity with our Baptist neighbors whose loss certainly hit close to home. Two days later, the Rev. Rick Murray sent a beautiful note of thanks to our parish, which I would like to share:

Dear Reverend Morris and the People of the Church of Regina Coeli,

The congregation of the Hyde Park Baptist Church appreciates your expression of sympathy, the Mass Card, and flowers in the aftermath of the terrible tragedy that happened in Texas. The civic celebration of Thanksgiving is unique in that peoples of all faiths gather in their homes with friends and families to share familial love, fellowship, and good food. There is a Catholic element to the civic celebration of Thanksgiving. In *The Catechism of the Catholic Church* (2nd edition), we read:

The inexhaustible richness of this sacrament is expressed in the different names we give it. Each name evokes certain aspects of it. It is called:

Eucharist, because it is an action of thanksgiving to God.

The Greek words *eucharistein* and *eulogein* recall the Jewish blessings that proclaim – especially during a meal – God's works: creation, redemption, and sanctification.

The word *Eucharist* means *thanksgiving*.

Unfortunately, Thanksgiving can be a time of sadness for those who are in need, those who are alone, and those who are touched by tragedy. Sadness will certainly be the looming companion this Thanksgiving among our brothers and sisters in Texas. So as we prepare for the upcoming Thanksgiving holiday, we commend to prayer those who are in need, and we are so grateful for our parishioners who continue to go to great lengths to reach out to the poor, the sick, the lonely, and those who suffer in body, mind, and spirit.
