True Ecumenism

Last week, I had the opportunity to have a most pleasant phone conversation with our neighbor in Christ, Pastor Rick Murray of the Hyde Park Baptist Church on Route 9G in town. We discussed our concerns about the abrogation of the role of parents as the first teachers of their children in the ways of faith, and how radical secularism is becoming the new “religion” in our schools. The roots of this phenomenon go back to the 1962 United States Supreme Court ruling, *Engel v. Vitale*, which ruled as unconstitutional, the recitation of prayer in public schools. However, in recent years the hostility to even the mention of God in the classroom has reached almost organic levels, taking on new appetites. It is an unfortunate ruling that has been enshrined in America now for almost sixty years. Some things just have to be accepted. But all that Pastor Murray and I wished for in our talk was that *parents could be allowed to be parents*.

When I hung up the telephone, it dawned on me: Pastor Murray and I were involved in an ecumenical dialogue. And it was *true ecumenism*...a Baptist pastor and a Catholic priest discussing the most important issue of all ... the respect for the unborn, the dignity of the human person, and the rights of parents and the family. It was very exciting.

Fortunately, Regina Coeli Parish has a very good and happy relationship with our brothers and sisters of the many Christian denominations in Hyde Park. But there was something extraordinary and memorable about this particular phone conversation. I certainly look forward to having some “Lenten” coffee with Pastor Murray next week.

A resurgence of local, state, and national public policies that pose a threat to the rights of the unborn, and the dignity of the human family and the rights of parents should be the cause of great distress for all peoples of good will and reason. With that said, after Easter and our May parish mission, we will re-create our parish Pro-Life committee. Keep posted, and pray for its success!

REVIEW OF ADORATION CHAPEL GUIDELINES IN THE EVENT OF INCLEMENT WEATHER

In the event of inclement weather, please tune into 92.1 FM for school closing listings, or on the web, search “Hyde Park Central School District,” hpcsd.org. If the district deems it necessary for a school closing or a delayed opening, the Adoration Chapel will be closed and reopen the following day after the 9:00 a.m. Mass.

Just a friendly reminder too, that the exposed Blessed Sacrament is never to be left unattended. On March 25, 2004, the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments in Rome issued the Instruction, *Redemptionis Sacramentum: On Certain Matters to be Observed and Avoided Regarding the Holy Eucharist*. In this instruction, Exposition of the Holy Eucharist, and the care and protection of the Eucharist is specifically addressed:

[#138] Still, the Most Blessed Sacrament, when exposed, *must never be left unattended even for the briefest space of time*. It should therefore be arranged that at least some of the faithful always be present at fixed times, even if they take alternating turns.

THE COLD AND INFLUENZA SEASON

The Sign of Peace at Mass is *optional*. A simple bow to the person next to you is quite adequate during the sign of peace. And if we encounter parishioners who do not hold their hand out, don't be offended. It is simply a safety precaution during this heightened time of worry regarding the flu epidemic. That's our motto here at Regina Coeli: *Safety First!*
