## Passiontide

Anyone who was born before 1960 or so can remember the custom of veiling statues and crucifixes in churches on the Fifth Sunday of Lent and remaining so until the Easter Vigil, restored by Pope Pius XII in the mid-1950's. It was a very powerful visual, in that the Church was entering into a more proximate preparation for the Passion and Death of the Lord.

Throughout the 1960's to the early 1990's, the custom of veiling the statues fell into disuse, primarily because the Passion Accounts were no longer read on the Fifth Sunday of Lent, after the promulgation of the *Missale Romanum*, April 3, 1969 (the Passion Accounts would subsequently be read on Palm Sunday, sometimes called "Passion Sunday" and Good Friday). However, the Preface of the Passion continues to this day to be read in the introduction of the Eucharistic Prayer at Mass, beginning on the Fifth Sunday of Lent. Hence the welcomed return of the practice of veiling statues on the Fifth Sunday of Lent until the Easter Vigil!

In his 2002 work, *Celebration of the Liturgical Year*, Australian liturgist Bishop Peter Elliott writes: "The custom of veiling crosses and images has much to commend it in terms of religious psychology, because it helps us to concentrate on the great essentials of Christ's work of Redemption."

## REVIEW OF ADORATION CHAPEL GUIDELINES IN THE EVENT OF INCLEMENT WEATHER

In the event of inclement weather, please tune into 92.1 FM for school closing listings, or on the web, search "Hyde Park Central School District," [hpcsd.org](http://hpcsd.org). If the district deems it necessary for a school closing or a delayed opening, the Adoration Chapel will be closed and reopen the following day after the 9:00 a.m. Mass.

Just a friendly reminder too, that the exposed Blessed Sacrament is never to be left unattended. On March 25, 2004, the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments in Rome issued the Instruction, *Redemptionis Sacramentum: On Certain Matters to be Observed and Avoided Regarding the Holy Eucharist*. In this instruction, Exposition of the Holy Eucharist, and the care and protection of the Eucharist is specifically addressed:

[#138] Still, the Most Blessed Sacrament, when exposed, *must never be left unattended even for the briefest space of time*. It should therefore be arranged that at least some of the faithful always be present at fixed times, even if they take alternating turns.

## THE COLD AND INFLUENZA SEASON

The Sign of Peace at Mass is *optional*. A simple bow to the person next to you is quite adequate during the sign of peace. **And if we encounter parishioners who do not hold their hand out, don't be offended.** It is simply a safety precaution during this heightened time of worry regarding the flu epidemic. That's our motto here at Regina Coeli: *Safety First!*
