Palm Sunday – Holy Week 2018

Come, and as we make our way up to the Mount of Olives, let us go to meet Christ, who is returning today from Bethany, and of his own will makes haste toward His own venerable passion, whereby He will bring to fulfillment the mystery of the salvation of mankind.

Saint Andrew of Crete (+AD 740)
Sermon Nine on Palm Sunday

Today, Jesus' triumphant procession into Jerusalem marks the holiest of weeks, when Jesus' mission of redemption is completed and believers are given the opportunity to share in eternal life. On Holy Thursday, Christ will institute the Eucharist and the priesthood. On Good Friday, Jesus will mount the Wood of the Cross as the supreme sacrifice for the forgiveness of our sins. There will be the starkness and emptiness of Holy Saturday, which will yield to the glory of the Easter Vigil.
