## Save the Date: Parish Mission, May 6-8, 2018

The month of May approaches and our thoughts immediately turn to ... the parish mission. Beginning with the weekend Masses of May 5 and 6, our parish family welcomes Father Justin Cinnante, O.Carm., a priest of the Carmelite Order, from Our Lady of Mount Carmel in Middletown, Orange County, New York, who will direct our parish mission. Father Justin is no stranger to the Archdiocese of New York. A native of the Bronx, New York, Father Justin was ordained a priest of the Archdiocese of New York by the late Edward Cardinal Egan in May 2007. After nine years of service as a parochial vicar, parish administrator, and high school chaplain in the Archdiocese, Father Justin entered the Carmelites in 2015 and professed simple vows in June 2017. Father Justin brings a wealth of experience as a spiritual and retreat director, and confessor – and parish priest.

The theme of our parish mission will be *Deepening Our Love for God and Bringing About the Triumph of the Hearts of Jesus and Mary in This World*. The purpose of a parish mission is that of continued spiritual renewal both personally and communally. Parish missions do marvels for a parish! The Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer (Redemptorists), whom many of us know from the former Mount Saint Alphonsus in Esopus, had established themselves as the masters of parish missions in the United States, especially in the 20<sup>th</sup> century. On the first night, the Redemptorist missionary priest would preach “hell fire and brimstone.” The following night, a missionary priest would wax effusively of the mercy of God. Father Justin will provide for our parish a very balanced and loving approach that will help us in our pilgrimage to Heaven.

This mission is for our parish, but please invite friends and family members from other parishes. Let's pack the church! The last evening of the mission, Tuesday May 8 will correspond with the fifty-second anniversary of the dedication of our main church by the late Francis Cardinal Spellman. So there will be so much of which to be thankful.

Please pray for the success of the parish mission and in your charity, keep Father Justin in your prayers. And it is not too early to plan ahead for our mission in May 2019, to be preached by Father Maximilian Buonocore, O.S.B., a Benedictine monk at Saint Benedict's Abbey, Newark, New Jersey.
