**HIS WORD TODAY**

**“He took him off by himself away from the crowd. He put his finger into the man’s ears, and spitting, touched his tongue, then he looked up to heaven and groaned and said to him ‘Ephphatha’ that is ‘Be opened.’ And immediately the man’s ears were opened, his speech impediment was removed, and he spoke plainly...They were exceedingly astonished and they said ‘He has done all things well.’”**

We can make a list of the miracles of Jesus. Some were cures from a distance, some taking one by the hand, some by a spoken word. Today we find touch, saliva, a groan and a word. We do not learn how the man reacted, but the people, ordered told to remain quiet, told the story.

Each one of us, at our baptism, found the minister touching our ears and tongue and told; As Jesus made the deaf to hear and dumb to speak, so may He open your ears to hear His word and your mouth to proclaim His praise.’ We were told that we, in the words of Pope Francis, are to be ‘Missionary Disciples.’ We have encountered Christ, turned to Him, accepted His teaching, and now are sent to live out that baptismal mandate. Though the man who was cured was anonymous, we are to tell others that He has done all things well.
