The Season of Lent also presents the faithful with some obligations that we must be reminded about. **FASTING** prescribes that only one full meal a day and two smaller meals may be taken to maintain strength but these two taken together should not equal another full meal. **FASTING OBLIGES FROM THE 18TH TO 59TH. ABSTINENCE forbids the eating of meat. ABSTINENCE OBLIGES FROM THE 14TH BIRTHDAY ON. ASH WEDNESDAY AND GOOD FRIDAY ARE DAYS OF FAST & ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT!!! ALL FRIDAYS OF LENT ARE DAYS OF ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT.**
