LENTEN OBLIGATIONS

Fasting prescribes that only one full meal a day and two smaller meals may be taken to maintain strength but these two taken together should not equal another full meal. Fasting obliges from the 18TH TO 59TH year. **Abstinence** forbids the eating of meat. Abstinence Obliges from 14TH Birthday on. Ash Wednesday & Good Friday are days of Fast & Abstinence from meat!!! All Fridays of Lent are day of Abstinence from meat.

The Events of Lent & Holy Week

Paschal Triduum from the Latin for “three days”, extends from evening Holy Thursday through Easter Sunday.

Maundy (Holy) Thursday gets its name from Jesus’ “new commandment” (*mandatum* in Latin) to love one another, which he spoke during the Passover meal when he washed his disciples’ feet and instituted the Holy Eucharist. Typically the Catholic Church now refers to this day as **Holy Thursday** and it is also notable for being the day on which the Chrism Mass is celebrated.

The Mass/Holy Hour will begin @ **7pm** & be held on the last Monday of each month. **On those dates, there will be no 7am Mass; the Mass will be at 7pm. February date: 2/29/15 at 7pm.**
