## *Light Your Lamps*

Our Gospel reading from Saint Luke for this Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time is often read at wake services and as a result, many priests can pretty much proclaim this gospel without even glancing down at the Book of Gospels. The powerful words of Jesus remind us of the necessity of being prepared for eternal life. We know not the day or the hour when Our Heavenly Father will call us from this earthly pilgrimage.

When Jesus spoke of “girding your loins” and “lighting your lamps,” His listeners knew exactly what He was talking about and the urgency of the imagery could not be missed. Father Francis Fernandez, in his seven volume twentieth century spiritual work, *In Conversation With God* best explains the historical circumstances behind Christ’s message:

In those days, the (Jewish people) wore loose-fitting garments, and a belt was used in order to walk and perform certain chores comfortably.

To *gird one’s loins* was a graphic example of the need to prepare for a journey, to dispose oneself for a struggle. Similarly, to *keep the lamps burning* is the attitude of one who keeps watch for or awaits the arrival of another.

When at the end of our lives Our Lord arrives, He should find us prepared, awake, And vigilant, like someone who lives for that day, serving out of love and determined to direct earthly realities – without losing his or her supernatural outlook – toward their true end...to love God more, win heaven, and serve others better, making the world a more just, human, and Christian place.

Wise word from Father Fernandez indeed!
