Recovery Sunday, September 25, 2016

More than twenty million Americans struggle with addiction, and countless families have at least one member who is afflicted with an addictive illness. Addictions manifest themselves primarily in abuse of alcohol, prescription and illicit drugs, and the more recent scourge, internet pornography. The Church, in her wisdom, and greatly concerned about these personal, familial, and societal challenges has designated the last Sunday in September as **Recovery Sunday**. For those who struggle with addictions, the greatest enemy is despair. No one is outside of the realm of Christ's mercy and restoration. One should never be embarrassed to seek out professional help when faced with the realization of an addictive behavior. And it is most essential to seek out God's mercy in the Sacrament of Penance. When we have recourse to regular confession, we are obviously forgiven of our sins, and we also receive sacramental graces that help us to overcome the struggles we all face in our daily lives. There have been countless stories of persons who have struggled with habitual sin, and after bringing that sin to the confessional, that sin eventually falls away. It might not happen overnight. But we must be patient.

Oftentimes we see in church bulletins, "Confessions on Saturday at 4:00 or anytime by appointment." We priests really mean that. Let's go a step further and add that no appointment is necessary. We are always available for the Sacrament of Penance. The greatness of the Sacrament of Penance is that it is the most resilient and "free-flowing" of the sacraments. It can be administered anytime and anywhere and is valid so long as the priest uses the formula proscribed by the Church. Never be afraid to approach a priest for the sacrament. We will drop all things if asked to hear a confession. And the more the priest goes to confession, the more Christ-like he will be when administering the Sacrament of Penance.

As we commemorate Recovery Sunday, we remember that all things are possible so long as we humbly approach Our Lord in prayer and in confidence. As Jesus told the great mystic St. Teresa of Avila, "My Father takes great delight in you and the Holy Spirit loves you." That applies to all of us!
