Solemnity of All Saints

Tuesday, November 1 is the Solemnity of All Saints. It is sort of like the Cooperstown or the All Star Game of the Church. On this wonderful day, we commemorate the heroic lives of all the saints – both those recognized by the Church through the process of canonization, as well as those who are not canonized, but are saints by virtue of their eternal reward of heavenly bliss. Just think. This is a day for our relatives and friends who have lived good and holy lives, and have gone before us marked with the sign of faith! Their sanctification of even the most ordinary of tasks have merited them a share in eternal life.

On Wednesday, November 2, the Church commemorates the Holy Souls, namely, those who have gone before us marked with the sign of faith, but must first undergo a purification in Purgatory. The doctrine of Purgatory makes great sense. If we are to behold the face of God in the New Jerusalem, we must be buffed up and polished to our new and perfected dignity. Sadly, the doctrine of Purgatory has been wrongheadedly challenged over the past few years, where the error of “universal salvation” has become almost normative in the Church. How sad it is to hear in a eulogy at a funeral Mass or wake service that the deceased is in heaven “looking down on us.” Indeed, maybe the deceased is in Heaven, but there is a good possibility that the person may be in Purgatory. “Instant canonizations,” as we priests call such paeans are actually unfair for the deceased, because if one is in Heaven, there is no need for prayers or Masses for the repose of that person’s soul. The late Father Benedict Groeschel, C.F.R., the great spiritual writer and founder of the Franciscan Friars of the Renewal said it all to our class in the seminary: “When I die, I hope that I get to Purgatory, because that means that one day, I will get to Heaven.”

We thank the Lord for the gift of the Communion of Saints, and we pray in a special way for all our loved ones who have gone before us, marked with the sign of faith!
