Plans and Hopes, 2017

We are now in the Second Sunday of Advent and with the new liturgical year well underway, it is the perfect time to discuss hopes for the coming year.

I can't believe that it has been more than five months since my arrival at Regina Coeli. I am so grateful to His Eminence, Cardinal Dolan for sending me to serve such a wonderful and faith-filled group of people. With the passage of time, there are some ideas that have been swirling around in my mind that I would love to share during this holy season.

-A New Parish Council. After the Christmas season, it will be high time to bring back a parish council. I would think perhaps eight members (plus the priests, deacons, and the coordinator of religious education) would be adequate for a parish the size of Regina Coeli. There will be elected members, plus ex officio members appointed by the pastor. -Parish Choir. If I had a penny for every compliment I received regarding the beautiful work of our choir at my installation as pastor on October 23, 2016, the parish would have billions of dollars! With that said, a more regular use of the parish choir at our Masses would truly enrich the worship in our beautiful church.

-Children's Choir for the 9:30 a.m. Sunday Mass. This possibility has been discussed with the music committee of the parish. Many parishes in the Archdiocese of New York have such choirs and they marvelously enhance the dignity, beauty...and simplicity of the Roman liturgy. And it also allows for reasonable participation of the children in the liturgy.

-Senior Group. Many parishes have senior groups that go by various names such as "Golden Age Club" or "Leisure Club," and so on. Whatever it may be called, it is very important that we reach out to our "55 and up," parishioners, of which I am a proud member!

-Rental Properties. In the not too distant past, it was very rare to see a Catholic school shuttered. Now sadly, it has become the norm in many dioceses throughout the United States. And although our school building is used for various functions such as religious education, CYO, various parish groups and fairs, it is essential that rental possibilities be pursued. Various otions are currently being investigated and the parishioners will certainly be kept informed about new developments -Wednesday Evening Masses During the Penitential Season of Lent. Lent will be here before we know it... Ash Wednesday falls on March 1, 2017. Plans are in place for a 7:30 p.m. evening Mass every Wednesday during Lent. There are so many wonderful priests in the Dutchess County Deanery, and it would be very good for our parish to get to know some of them. Perhaps inviting a different priest to offer Mass and preach might be something very special for the parish. -Coeli Fest. Be there, Aloha! The Coeli Fest lives on! Some new and delightful surprises await!

Thank you so much for your prayers and support. The year 2017 is looking up for our wonderful parish!
