The Advent of Winter

With the snowstorm this past Monday morning, December 5, we were quickly reminded that the Hudson Valley winter is fast upon us.

As the snow begins to fly, it may be a good idea to review policies regarding snow and closures in the parish.

Daily Mass

In the past, it was the policy that if the school district was closed, the church would be closed and a Mass without a congregation would be offered in the rectory so as to fulfill the Mass obligation. As of this winter, no masses in the main church will be canceled regardless of the weather. Mass will indeed be offered every day. It is imperative that the Mass be made available to our parishioners. However, for safety reasons, our parishioners should exercise extreme caution in the event of immoderate or dangerous weather. Our Lord does not expect that we venture out in bad weather to attend Holy Mass. Prudence is the key. Even if the priest is the only one present in the church for Mass, as liturgy, it still is a public act.

Eucharistic Adoration

The parish has maintained, and will continue to practice a policy that if schools are delayed in opening, Eucharistic Adoration will be delayed for the same number of hours. In the event of a full day school closure, Adoration will be closed all day even if the weather improves. The church, however, will be open until late afternoon for those who would like to spend time in prayer in the main church.

In the event of a serious snowstorm during the day and into the evening and the night, it will be the discretion of the pastor, as the custodian of the Eucharist, to close the Adoration Chapel without previous notification in order to repose the Blessed Sacrament in the tabernacle in the main church. Such a decision will be for two reasons: 1) The exposed Blessed Sacrament is never to be left in the monstrance unattended, and 2) to support the prudential decision of our parishioners to remain indoors and at home during time so dangerous storms.

The old Erie Railroad used as their slogan "Safety First." As we begin the winter months, may we also remember that the safety of our parishioners is paramount. And before we know it, Spring will be upon us!
