SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME – FEBRUARY 12, 2017

This past weekend, February 4th and 5th, our parish kicked off the Cardinal's Annual Appeal for 2017. Many thanks for taking the time during last week's masses to listen to my presentation on this important endeavor. As I mentioned from the pulpit, Regina Coeli Church has a rich history of great generosity regarding time as well as financial resources.

The archdiocesan goal for the Appeal is \$20 million. Our parish goal is \$78,000. This goal was calculated based upon collections from the parish during the fiscal year, 2015. Gifts to the Annual Appeal help continue the mission of bringing the Gospel message to the people of New York, the United States, and the world. Specifically the following ministries and services particularly benefit from the Appeal:

-The offices (including the Archives of the Archdiocese of New York, where I served for more than five years), ministries, and programs throughout the Archdiocese of New York, that nurture and encourage growth in the faith.

-The education of children both in Catholic schools and parish-based religious education programs.

-The community of retired priests and religious in the Archdiocese of New York.

-Saint Joseph's Seminary, Yonkers, and Cathedral College, Douglaston. Without priests, there is no Eucharist.

-The works of Catholic Charities.

Hopefully, our parish will achieve the goal set forth by the Archdiocese of New York. If we do achieve that goal (of which I am very optimistic), we will receive a rebate. This rebate policy is that any donations received over our goal will be subject to a 60/40 split, with our parish keeping sixty percent and the Appeal retaining forty percent over the goal. Such rebates will be paid twice, namely in October 2017 and March 2018. So if we get our goal, we have that going for us, which is nice.

Thank you for your consideration and generosity.

Please know that I would never ask for something and then just sit back and observe. I have made my donation to the Cardinal's Appeal and according to our Appeal representative, Amanda Monti, my donation is considered a major gift. It was a sacrifice well worth making. I am so very much looking forward to the events and programs over the next few months regarding the Appeal.
