It's Never Too Early to Start Thinking of Lent

Last Sunday, February 12 was Septuagesima Sunday, or the ninth Sunday before Easter and the third Sunday before Ash Wednesday. We are now in the period known as "Shrovetide," or the pre-Lenten season that ends on Shrove Tuesday (the day before Ash Wednesday, also known as Mardi Gras). With Lent quickly approaching, it is a good time to speak about a nice little addition to our Lenten Schedule here at Regina Coeli.

When I was the pastor of Blessed Sacrament Church in Staten Island, there was a special Mass each Wednesday evening during Lent, offered by one of the local pastors. It gave our good people the opportunity to meet their neighboring priests, and the parishioners so very much looked forward to the Masses.
