ASH WEDNESDAY

Three more shopping days until Ash Wednesday! Many of us approach Lent with trepidation. Am I going to be able to remain steadfast to my spiritual and penitential resolve? A revered priest of the Archdiocese of New York, who has since gone back to God, once quipped: "I wish Lent was four weeks and Advent was six weeks." One of the most beautiful meditations on the penitential season of Lent can be found in the Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy, Sacrosanctum Concilium, 109-110, from the Second Vatican Ecumenical Council, December 4, 1963. This Council document will be of great assistance as we approach Lent:

109. The two elements which are especially characteristic of Lent – the recalling of Baptism or the preparation for it, and Penance – should be given greater emphasis in the liturgy and in liturgical catechesis. It is by means of them that the Church prepares the faithful for the celebration of Easter, while they listen more attentively to God's word and devote more time to prayer. Accordingly:

(a) more use is to be made of the baptismal features which are part of the Lenten liturgy; some features which had formed part of an earlier tradition are to be restored as may seem advisable;

(b) the same may be said of the penitential elements. Further, as well as pointing out the social consequences of sin, the catechesis must impress on the minds of the faithful the distinctive character of penance as a detestation of sin because it is an offence (sic) against God. The role of the church in penitential practices is not to be omitted, and the need to pray for sinner should be emphasized.

110. During Lent, penance should be not only internal and individual but also external and social. The practice of penance should be encouraged in ways suited to the present day, to different regions, and to individual circumstances.

But the paschal fast must be kept sacrosanct. It should be celebrated everywhere on Good Friday, and where possible, should be prolonged through Holy Saturday so that the faithful may attain the joys of Easter Sunday with uplifted and receptive minds.

May the holy and penitential season of Lent is a time for renewal and rebirth for all the members of our parish family.
