Our Parish Mission, May 6-9, 2017

On *faith*, we read in the Catechism of the Catholic Church:

By faith, man completely submits his intellect and his will to God. With his whole being, man gives his assent to God the revealer. Sacred Scripture calls this human response to God, the author of revelation, “the obedience of faith” (CCC 143).

The Catechism continues:

Faith is first of all a personal adherence of man to God. At the same time, and inseparably, it is a free assent to the whole truth that God is revealed. As personal adherence to God and assent to His truth, Christian faith differs from our faith in any human person. It is right and just to entrust oneself wholly to God and to believe absolutely what He says. It would be futile and false to place such faith in a creature. (CCC 150).

Faith is a free gift from our Divine Lord. It is offered to all, but not all have accepted God’s magnanimous generosity. Faith is not emotional or carried along by the whims and fads of society. For one to reject any of the teachings of Christ is contrary to faith and the assent to the truth that is obligatory for all Christians. Our parish mission will help each and every one of us to dip deeply into the depths of our faith and will lead us to a conformity of our intellect to God’s will and His timeless and saving truths.

As we begin the month of May, the month of Our Lady, we look to Mary at Nazareth as the most complete model of complete surrender to God’s truth and love: “And Mary said, Behold, the handmaid of the Lord; let it be unto me according to thy word” (Luke 1: 38).

Father William Garrott, O.P., a native of Hagerstown, Maryland, was ordained a priest of the Order of Preachers (Dominicans) in 1994. He is a member of the Province of Saint Joseph based in New York City. Fr. Garrott has a master’s degree in spiritual theology from the Pontifical University of Saint Thomas Aquinas (Angelicum) in Rome. Currently serving the Catholic community at the University of Virginia, Charlottesville, Virginia, Father has served as a parochial vicar, campus minister, and director of vocations. Father Garrott has preached over one hundred parish missions throughout the United States and Canada, using his musical abilities. Welcome to Father Garrott!
