New Parish Sign

For those of us who may not have attended the 11:30 Mass, this past Mother's Day, May 14, we had the opportunity to bless the new parish sign that graces the front of our church. Many thanks to Mr. Paul Beichert, prop. Of Timely Signs of Kingston, Inc., who facilitated the production of the sign, and Gillian Barnard, a graphic artist at Timely Signs (and a member of the Bruderhof) who made all the design features come together.

Lots of work went into the sign. First there was the dream...we really need a new sign! Then on February 13, Mr. Beichert came to our parish from Kingston, armed with a camera, taking pictures of the exterior features of the church building. A color scheme was discussed that would harmonize with the bronzes and beiges of the church. I suggested the incorporation into the sign, of the stylized Marian "M" surmounted with a crown, the symbol of Mary, Queen of Heaven (which we will now use as our parish logo). A few weeks later, the computerized rendering arrived with the stunning rendition of the sign. Perfect! There was no need to make a single change to Mrs. Barnard's beautiful work of art!

What truly finishes off this sign is Mrs. Bernard's replication of the church's stained glass windows that grace the top of the sign. This makes the sign truly our own! There is nothing "store-bought" or "cookie cutter" about our sign. Unique indeed!

A parish sign, simplistic as this might sound, can indicate the well-being and health of a parish. I guess having worked for a flagmaker before I entered the seminary, I myself will often notice signs with their colors, letters, and images before I take in the physical structure of the church buildings themselves.

I am so happy that I was able to give this sign as a personal gift to our parish family. I only ask three favors in return. Whenever you pass by the sign, could you (1) say a prayer that I may be a good and holy priest and (2) a dedicated servant to the people of Regina Coeli and (3) and in your charity, remember the deceased members of the Morris, Petry, Gaffney, and Connolly families?
