SOLEMNITY OF THE HOLY TRINITY - JUNE 11, 2017

Everyone Knows Hyde Park, New York

Back in April of this past year, one of my childhood friends, CMDR Noreen Hagerty-Ford, USN, JAGC invited me to give the invocation and the benediction at her retirement ceremony at the Navy Yard in Washington, D.C. It was a very moving ceremony – almost liturgical in its scope. With the presence of three U.S. Navy admirals, including the Judge Advocate General of the Navy (whom I was told is a daily communicant) and a retired Coast Guard Rear Admiral and former Chief Usher at the White House (also a very devout Catholic who counted as relatives one bishop, two priests, and two religious sisters), I approached the podium as nervous as a long-tailed cat in a room full of rocking chairs. At the reception, I had the chance to meet many people, including a grade school and high school classmate who I had not seen since 1978 – and who incidentally lives now in *New Hyde Park*, our neighbor to the south in Long Island. When asked where I served as a priest, telling them I was in Hyde Park, New York, the almost unanimous response was “Wow! The home of Franklin and Eleanor Roosevelt” and “that sounds like a pretty important and historical parish assignment.” Everyone knows Hyde Park!

Hyde Park gets some billing in a new book by author and historian, Brad Miner and journalist, banker, and former Director of the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey, George Marlin. In [Sons of Saint Patrick: A History of the Archbishops of New York from Daguer John to Timmytown](#) (San Francisco: Ignatius Press, 2017), Marlin and Miner recounted a letter from President Roosevelt on the occasion of the installation of Archbishop Francis Spellman as the sixth Archbishop of New York in 1939:

I am deeply regretful that I cannot come to the installation –
but my heart and my thoughts will be with you. A little later in the summer you must come to us at Hyde Park and incidentally the good habit of staying with us when you come to see your flocks in Dutchess County.

Now that hand-written letter from our neighbor, FDR certainly resonates with us. Go to the parking lot at Vanderbilt or the Roosevelt Presidential Library and we will find license plates from all over the United States. We can just walk down the block and experience American History!
