Safety First

On Tuesday afternoon, June 20, 2017, a rather frightening note expressing virulent-Catholicism (its contents so offensive that they cannot be expressed in this notice) was taped to the front door of the church building. What is particularly distressing is that this act occurred in broad daylight. The note was given to the Hyde Park Police Department and an investigation into its source continues.

This incident serves as a reminder to exercise vigilance during our times of prayer in the church. Thanks to Vector security, security cameras have been installed at all 3 entrances to the church, as well as at the rectory.

WELCOME FATHER THOMAS LUTZ!

His Eminence Cardinal Timothy Dolan has appointed Father Thomas Lutz, longtime parochial vicar and later-pastor of Saint Augustine's Church, Highlands, Ulster County as chaplain at Our Lady of Lourdes High School in Poughkeepsie. Since there is not a priest residence at Lourdes, Father Lutz inquired about residency at Regina Coeli, which I enthusiastically accepted. Ordained in 1993, Father Lutz will be given the canonical status of "residency." Please note that Father will not be not be a parochial vicar here and I am fully aware that his responsibilities of daily Mass and pastoral care at Lourdes will free him up to assist our parish only on Sundays.

Father Lutz is no stranger to Hyde Park. A native of Poughkeepsie, Father Lutz's father was the long-time proprietor of a drugstore on 9G in East Park. Father Lutz has relatives, friends, and acquaintances here at Regina Coeli. Looks like a perfect fit! We will be seeing Father Lutz on Sunday's beginning in September. ---Fr. Michael Morris

Father Pani's Return to India

I know and fully understand the concerns about Father Pani's rather quick departure from Regina Coeli last month. Light can be shone on this event through the following timeline.

On Wednesday, May 3, 2017, Father Pani departed for India for his customary visit to his homeland. Midpoint in that time, on Thursday, June 1, 2017, I received an e-mail, dated Tuesday, May 31, 2017, from Father Pani, informing me that he would be departing Regina Coeli for the Church of Saint Lucy, the Bronx, quote "...after I come back." The exact date of his departure from our parish was not made clear.

Fr. Pani's May 31 e-mail certainly came as a great surprise to our staff and me, but kind sentiments were expressed toward the parish, the staff of Regina Coeli, and myself. The following is an excerpt from the e-mail:

Fr., I have an opportunity to serve in the Parish of Saint Lucy in [the] Bronx. Though I have a great love for Regina Coeli that I cannot lose from my heart, yet I think I should have a different faith experience in St. Lucy that might be good to me.

However, upon Father's return on Wednesday, June 21, 2017, events took on a new direction. Firstly, Father returned with an undisclosed illness and was unable to offer Masses that following weekend. Although upon his return, Father did inform me that he would be leaving Regina Coeli for Saint Lucy's on Saturday, July 1; on Wednesday, June 28, after morning daily Mass, Father Pani told me that he would be leaving the parish that very afternoon and the following day, would return to India, to stay with his sister and recover from his illness for a month, with the intentions of eventually going back to a parish somewhere in New York, but *not* to Saint Lucy's, which desperately needed a new parochial vicar immediately and with no delay.

The standard completion of "separation papers" required by the office of Priest Personnel of the Archdiocese of New York, when a priest serving in the Archdiocese of New York leaves a parish for a new assignment, necessitated my contacting Msgr. Edward Weber, Director of Priest Personnel. In a conversation with Msgr. Weber on Wednesday morning, June 28, I was informed that since Father Pani was not seeking "incardination" as a priest of the Archdiocese of New York (a formal canonical process where a priest of another diocese, and in this case, the Archdiocese of New York), he would be subject to archdiocesan regulations requiring international priests to depart the archdiocese after five years of residency. Father Pani had been serving in the Archdiocese of New York for seven years and with that Msgr. Weber informed me that in compliance with archdiocesan policy, Father Pani's service in the Archdiocese of New York would be completed as of July 1, 2017.

So as is quite evident, all of these events pieced together rather rapidly. The good news is that we received an e-mail from Father Pani on Wednesday, July 5 informing us that his health has greatly improved. Blessings to Father Pani as he begins a new chapter of his priesthood in his homeland. The good people of Regina Coeli are most grateful for his apostolate in Hyde Park. As soon as his new address in India is available to us, it will be published in our parish bulletin. In the meantime, the greatest gift that we can give to Father Pani is prayer.
