Bermuda, 2017!

The British Overseas Territory of Bermuda has an interesting Catholic history going back to its “accidental” discovery in 1612. The Diocese of Hamilton in Bermuda was established in 1967. Blessed Paul VI visited Bermuda for forty-five minutes, on a layover to Rome upon his return from the Medellin Conference, Colombia, August 1968. The pontiff gave the recently-created diocese a beautiful chalice for the Cathedral of Saint Theresa in the capital, Hamilton, which I have had the privilege of using at Holy Mass on many occasions. Although the primary religious denomination in Bermuda is Anglican, about six thousand of the sixty thousand residents of the twenty-seven square mile main island are Catholic. The Diocese of Hamilton is shepherded by Bishop Wieslaw Spiewak, C.R., the former superior general of the Resurrectionist Fathers. There are six priests on the island – five Resurrectionist Fathers from Canada and Poland, and one diocesan priest. Two years ago, two permanent deacons were ordained to serve the Catholic community on the island.

For more than thirty years, priests of the Archdiocese of New York have been invited to serve for two-to-three week stints at the five parishes on the island while the resident priests return to Canada or Poland for summer break. Priests like myself have not asked for the assignment, but have simply “fallen into it,” so to speak. Bishop *emeritus* Robert Kurtz would refer to the New Yorkers as “the Bermuda Regiment,” while we would jocularly refer to the time in Bermuda as “a hardship assignment – someone has to do it”! Our neighbor to the north, Father Douglas Crawford, pastor of Good Shepherd, Rhinebeck, and Msgr. Joseph Martin, pastor *emeritus* of Saint Mary's Church, Fishkill are local alumni of the “Bermuda Regiment.”

This past January, the Rev. Paul Voisin, C.R. (a friend of Mariopolis Luminosa here in Hyde Park), the vicar general of the Diocese of Hamilton and rector of the cathedral, invited me to return to Bermuda for ten days in July, to serve at the cathedral. I will be in Bermuda from July 19 through August 1. Many thanks to Father Prince, our former pastor, Father Vianney, Father Lutz, and our deacons for helping at Regina Coeli during my days in Bermuda. Your intentions will be remembered in daily Mass at the cathedral.
