The Special Feast of Our Parish The Memorial of Our Lady, Queen and Mother Tuesday, August 22, 2017

This coming Tuesday, August 22, 2017, our parish will celebrate our special feast, the *Memorial of the Queenship of Mary*. Pope Pius XII, in his October 11, 1954 encyclical, *Ad caeli Reginam*, instituted this memorial to be celebrated on May 31, the last day of the month of Our Lady. After the second Vatican Ecumenical Council (October 11, 1962-December 8, 1965), the memorial was transferred to its current date, August 22 – the octave of the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. In his March 25, 1987 Marian encyclical, *Redemptoris Mater*, Saint John Paul II weaves Mary's service as the "true disciple of Christ" with her sinlessness and her royalty: *To serve Christ is to reign with Him...Her glory in serving is completely compatible with her royal exaltation.*

If we look through the P. J. Kenedy* *Official Catholic Directory*, we would be hard-pressed to find many parishes named *Regina Coeli*. Sure, there are countless parishes under the patronage of Our Lady, but few have the melodic name, *Regina Coeli*. And it has been ours since 1863!

Every August 22, the Legion of Mary and our good parishioners who attend the 9:00am Mass sponsor a little social in the back of the church immediately following the 9:00am Mass. When the weather allows, the gathering spills out onto the front steps and the passers-by can see that this is indeed a special day. If schedules permit, please join us for Mass and a little social after Mass this Tuesday. Also, immediately after the social, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed until 5:00[m in the main church, rather than the Adoration Chapel, again to heighten awareness of our special day.

There is an old saying, "The Finger of God is everywhere." No small coincidence that the Dutchess falls during the time of our feast day. Mary certainly protects us and certainly through her intercession, our parish Steak-Out continues!
