## Re-activating Our Regina Coeli Choir

So important is music to the liturgical life of the Church that on December 25, 1955, Pope Pius XII, building upon the liturgical reforms of his predecessor, Saint Pius X (pontificate, 1903-1914) issued the Encyclical *Musicae Sacrae*, On Sacred Music. The use of sacred music is not for entertainment or the glorification to self, but solely for the worship of God. In this magnificent encyclical, the late pontiff reflects upon the words of Saint Augustine:

*“Music, that is the science or the sense of proper modulation, is likewise given by God’s generosity to mortals having rational souls in order to lead them to higher things.”*

*St. Augustine, Homily #33*

Pius XII adds:

*Music is among the many and great gifts of nature with which God, in whom is the harmony of the most perfect concord and the most perfect order, has enriched men, whom he has created in His image and likeness. Together with the other liberal arts, music contributes to spiritual joy and the delight of the soul.*

And as Pope Emeritus Benedict has so often said, “Liturgy impacts society.”

Regina Coeli has been blessed with a magnificent choir under the leadership of Kevin Hanyak, Carol and Kevin Becker, and Linda Dalmer. However, the choir sings primarily on major feasts, which is sad, because they are so good. Their talents should not be “hidden under a bushel basket.” Thankfully, the choir is going to begin singing once a month at the 11:30 a.m. Sunday Mass. Hopefully soon, the choir will be singing even more often – perhaps weekly. I am certainly committed to doing all I possibly can to support the choir. And we need your help. New members are most welcome. No need to be another Edith Piaf or Enrico Caruso! And some of the best singers in this whole wide world do not even know how to read music!

Please pray for the success of our parish choir. Perhaps we can place our choir under the protection and guidance of Saint Cecilia, the patroness of music.
