## Columbus Day, 2017

In 1942, the noted Harvard historian, Samuel Eliot Morison published one of the great biographies of Christopher Columbus (1451-1506), *Admiral of the Ocean Sea*. Our neighbor, President Franklin D. Roosevelt (an accomplished seaman in his own right and Assistant Secretary of the Navy from 1912 to 1921) was so enamored with the book that he ultimately promoted Dr. Morison from Lieutenant Commander in the United States naval Reserve, to Rear Admiral, Upper Half. President Roosevelt, echoing the sentiments of Morison, saw Columbus for what he truly was: a great navigator, cartographer, and explorer who truly elevated the standards of seamanship and exploration. In 1937, Roosevelt established Columbus Day as a national holiday to be commemorated on October 12, the anniversary of the explorer's arrival at San Salvador in modern-day Dominican Republic. In 1971, Columbus Day-Observed was moved to the second Monday in October. Interestingly, it was the Catholic fraternal organization, the Knights of Columbus who were the catalyst behind the elevation of Columbus Day to the status of a national holiday. Prior to 1937, a number of states and localities commemorated the discovery of America with orations, parades, and gatherings.

With all his accomplishments in the areas of seafaring and exploration, there is one quality of Columbus that is frequently overlooked, and that was his outstanding faith and holiness. Accompanying his crew on his *four* voyages to the New World was a priest chaplain so as the crew could have access to the sacraments. Columbus also had a great devotion to Our Lady and prayed the Liturgy of the Hours on a daily basis.

Over the past few years, we have seen an immense challenge to the motives of Columbus's actions in the Americas. Attempts to vilify the explorer and remove him from the annals of history are cringe-worthy. It would be interesting to speculate how Christianity would have spread in the Americas without the efforts of Columbus. For this reason, among many, we owe a huge debt of gratitude to the Admiral of the Ocean Sea!
