VETERANS DAY 2017

Ninety-nine years ago, November 11, 1918, *the eleventh hour, the eleventh day, of the eleventh month*, Germany agreed to terms for the cessation of hostilities with the Allied Powers. The Allied and German parties met in a railroad car parked on a siding in the Compiegne Forest, Picardy, France. The Armistice which ended World War One was not a surrender *per se*, but a request by Germany to end hostilities, so as to accept a post-war order based upon President Woodrow Wilson's *Fourteen Points* of January 1918. The architect of the terms of the armistice was Marshal Ferdinand Foch, Supreme Commander of the Allied Forces in Europe. Marshal Foch was a devout Catholic who attended daily Mass. This was extraordinary for this time and place in that as a result of the French Separation of Church and State Laws of 1905, Foch's France was rife with anti-clericalism – which did not dissipate despite the carnage visited upon France during the Great War (the Faith however, was strong among the French soldiers and officers in the trenches). The French Prime Minister, Georges Clemenceau boasted of having never been baptized, and Marshal Joseph Joffre, commander-in-chief of the French forces Western Front, proudly ordered a dinner of pork on Good Friday, during the Battle of Verdun, Spring 1916. Be that as it may, on this day, throughout Europe and beyond, those who died in that horrible war of 1914-1918 are particularly remembered.

Armistice Day was proclaimed a federal holiday in 1936 by our neighbor, President Franklin Roosevelt. In 1954, President Dwight D. Eisenhower shifted emphasis from the Armistice to a day of gratitude for all servicemen and women who have served in the defense of the Republic. Hence, *Veterans Day* was born.

On this special day, we thank all our veterans who have served our nation so that we could be free. Even if those who we honor may not have served in combat, service in the military, regardless, entails incredible sacrifice. Imagine going from the freedoms of civilian life to the rigors of a disciplined military organization – and then transitioning back to civilian life? This is why we honor our veterans and we are deeply grateful for the sacrifices made.

Please join our parish family for a special wreath-laying ceremony at the flagpole after the 11:30am Mass on Sunday, November 12. To all our veterans, please be assured of our prayers of gratitude for service well-rendered.
