## THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD – JANUARY 7, 2018

### The Epiphany of the Lord 2018

When I was a boy – perhaps up through high school, and maybe beyond, I always lamented the passing of the Christmas season. I would dread seeing my parents' home devoid of Christmas decorations as we hunkered down for a bleak and cold Middle Atlantic States winter. As time went on, I outgrew my sadness with the progression from Christmas to the bleak winter months of January and February. It seems that this year, I have reverted to that sense of loss with the closing of the Christmas season. Maybe because for me personally, it was a particularly happy Advent and Christmas season. This was my second Christmas here at Hyde Park and adding to that sense of joy was the dedication and blessing of the new outdoor Nativity as well as the prevalence of the Nativity signs in Hyde Park and beyond. So rather than lamenting the passing of Christmas, I have to make sure that the memories of this past Christmas will be a great source of happiness in the coming New Year.

But Christmas is not over yet. Today we celebrate the Epiphany of the Lord. On this day, three “restless” and searching pagan (probably Persian) astrologers, Balthasar, Caspar, and Melchior, after completing a journey believed to have been over one thousand miles, found the infant Savior in the company of Our Lady, Saint Joseph, and the shepherds. On this day, Christ is made manifest to the peoples of all nations. My grandfather, Dominick C. Petry was born in Philadelphia on January 6, 1894. Because he was born on the Solemnity of the Epiphany, my great-grandparents gave him the middle name, “Caspar.” Faith and family life were one and such holy gestures were not uncommon. After the implementation of the Missal of Paul VI in 1970, the celebration of the Epiphany of the Lord was shifted from January 6 to the first Sunday after the Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God, January 1. Hence Epiphany is celebrated this year on this day, January 7, and the Christmas season will come to a close tomorrow, January 8, the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord.

It is more Christmas today than it was on Sunday morning, this past Christmas Eve. Merry Christmas to our wonderful parish family!
