OUR AMAZING DEACONS

And the twelve summoned the body of the disciples and said, "It is not right that we should give up preaching the word of God to serve tables. Therefore, brethren, pick out from among you seven men of good repute, full of the spirit and wisdom, whom we may appoint to this duty. But we will devote ourselves to prayer and to the ministry of the word...and they chose Stephen, a man filled with the Holy Spirit, and Philip, and Prochorus, and Nicanor, and Timon, and Parmenas, and Nicholaus, a proselyte of Antioch. These they set before the apostles, and they prayed and laid hands upon them.

- Acts 6, 2-6 (Revised Standard Edition)

There we have it – the scriptural account of the first deacons ordained by the apostles.

Regina Coeli is blessed with six deacons: Frank Gohl (ordained 1986), James Hayes (ordained 1988), Jerry Lindley (1999), Mark O'Sullivan (ordained 2002), Peter Dalmer (ordained 2008), and Ken Briskey (ordained 2016). A deacon is a cleric as opposed to a layman, who joins the presbyterate (priesthood) and the episcopacy (bishopric) in the threefold structure of Holy Orders. Ordination, like the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation leave an *indelible character* on the soul. Baptism can be never taken away; Confirmation can be never remitted; and the character of Holy Orders remains always with the man who is ordained a deacon, priest or bishop.

Although the diaconate has its roots in the apostolic era (that period immediately after the Resurrection and Ascension of Christ, lasting until the death of the last apostle, Saint John), the diaconate has witnessed not necessarily changes, but more so an evolution. By the completion of the first millennium, the diaconate in the Latin Rite Church was no longer an end in itself, but became *transitional* in nature in that it was a step to ordination to the priesthood. There were a few exceptions, namely Saint Francis of Assisi (1182-1226), who was a deacon. Even today, all priests are first ordained deacons, usually for six months to a year prior to ordination to the priesthood. I myself was ordained to the diaconate in December 1988, and those five months prior to ordination to the priesthood were truly a blessing indeed (Cardinal Dolan frequently reminds his priests, and rightly so that we priests are in the eyes of the Church, deacons...so I guess if we include Father Lutz, Father Prince, and me, Regina Coeli has *nine* deacons).

The restoration of a *permanent* diaconate had been discussed often during the second millennium. Right here in the United States, the possibility of a permanent diaconate was suggested at the Second Plenary Council of Baltimore in 1866. But it was not until the Second Vatican Ecumenical Council (1962-1965) that the subject of the restoration of the permanent diaconate was addressed on a more serious level. In 1967, Blessed Paul VI issued *Sacrum Diaconatus Ordinem*, a *motu proprio* establishing guidelines for the restoration of a permanent diaconate. Here in the Archdiocese of New York, the late Terence Cardinal Cooke ordained the first class of men to serve as permanent deacons in 1973. Today, three hundred and ninety deacons serve the people of God in the Archdiocese of New York.

Next week, we will discuss the important roles of the deacon in the life of our parish, as well as the Universal Church. In the meantime, pray for Deacons Hayes, Jerry, Frank, Ken, Mark, and Peter. Theirs is a critical apostolate and an immense gift to our parish.
