## *Roe versus Wade, Forty-Five Years Later*

Tomorrow, January 22, 2018 marks the tragic, forty-fifth anniversary of the Supreme Court of the United States decision, *Roe v. Wade*, legalizing abortion in all fifty states, the District of Columbia and the American territories of Guam, Puerto Rico, American Samoa, Northern Marianas, and the United States Virgin Islands. According to the United States Centers for Disease Control in Atlanta, Georgia, there has been a staggering 59,115,995 abortions in the United States from 1973 to 2017. The World Health Organization estimates that there are upwards of forty to fifty million abortions worldwide every year. These are frightening statistics that should cause all peoples regardless of faith or political persuasion sadness and fear. As Jesus told the women of Jerusalem as He carried his cross to Calvary, "For if they do this when the wood is green, what will happen when it is dry" (Luke 23:31, RSV). There is a domino effect here. First, the Lambeth Conference of the Anglican Communion, meeting in 1930, caved to Margaret Sanger's burgeoning birth control movement. Then abortion was legalized first in New York State in 1971 and in all fifty states in 1973. The 1990's and early 2000's witnessed the beginning of the assisted suicide movement, targeting the sick, the other-abled, and the elderly. The morbid puzzle seems to fit together – *For if they do this when the wood is green, what will happen when it is dry.*

The Church has consistently been the great defender of the cause of human life. And it is through the great Sacrament of Penance that so many men women who have been victimized by the abortion culture, have been rescued from despair and have been restored and healed by Christ's love and mercy. But as Jesus says, "This kind cannot be cast out by anything but prayer and fasting" (Mark 9:29, RSV). In response to the urgent call of Christ, there will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament on Sunday evening, January 21 in the main church from 7:00 p.m. until 9:00 p.m. Please join us in quiet prayer for the cause of life.
